MANISTEE COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION INVESTS \$250,000 TO HELP COUNTY'S SMALL BUSINESSES

MANISTEE, MICHIGAN – Manistee County small businesses seeking to grow will benefit from a \$250,000 "impact investment" from the <u>Manistee County Community Foundation</u> in <u>Venture North Funding and Development</u>, a nonprofit that provides affordable loans, small grants and no-cost consulting to help small business grow.

As a Community Development Financial Institution (CDFI), Venture North gives priority to providing help to small businesses in areas with economic challenges in its 10-county northwest Michigan region. In its 15-years of operation, within this region, Venture North has made 160 affordable loans amounting to \$9.5 million while leveraging an additional \$32 million that has created 495 new jobs while retaining 542 jobs — all with small businesses, often with nine or fewer employees. They have also awarded 350 small grants totaling \$1.2 million and provided no-cost consulting to 1,500 businesses.

"We are grateful for the Community Foundation's support," said Laura Galbraith, Venture North President. "We will deploy this funding in the form of affordable loans to small Manistee County businesses. Our loans have terms that match the cashflow of the business client and can be used for purposes and in amounts that are often not supported with lending from other sources. Our experience is that we are often able to leverage our lending by 2x or more to spread the benefits even wider to our clients.

The MCCF recently launched an impact investing program aimed at expanding its positive impact on the Manistee County community by investing a portion of its assets locally rather than in its traditional portfolio. Impact investments are investments made with the intention of generating both a financial and social return.

"The mission of Venture North – lifting up small businesses and communities that need help the most – is also a great match with our philanthropic goals involving the well-being of Manistee County community," said Laura Heintzelman, President and Chief Executive Officer of the Manistee County Community Foundation. "We hope businesses throughout the County will connect with Venture North to see how their growth plans will benefit from our Investment."
