From Therapy to Cheese Making

VENTURE NORTH HELPING SMALL BUSINESSES AT RECORD PACE

TRAVERSE CITY, MICHIGAN – A robust variety of northwest Michigan small businesses have benefitted during the record pace of Venture North Funding and Development in providing affordable growth capital during the first four months of 2024.

The businesses are located in Arcadia, Manistee, East Bay Township, Frankfort and Traverse City.
